SKATING PERMISSION FORM – PRIMARY

Primary students in Divisions 5 to 8 will be skating at Kensington Arena (6159 Curtis Street on the mornings of **Wednesday, January 11th** and **Friday, January 27th**. Through the generosity of our PAC, there is no cost for this event however there is a cost if skate rental is required (see below).



We will need parent volunteers to drive these students to the arena and back to school. Past experience has shown that it is difficult for young children to handle the long walk carrying skates. If you are able to assist with driving and tying skates, please complete the appropriate part of the tear-off below.

Children under 40 lbs. in weight **must** be in a forward-facing car seat. Children over 40 lbs. but not yet 9 years of age or 4'9" tall must be in a booster seat. If your child needs a booster seat, please bring it to school on skating days. Other children do not require a car seat, but all must be strapped in using a seat belt, including the shoulder strap. By law, elementary school children cannot sit in the front seat of a car equipped with air bags. If you have not filled out a volunteer driver form this school year, please do so prior to the skating days.

Students will be skating from 10:45 to 11:45am on both days. Volunteer drivers need to be at the school by 10:00am to drive to the arena on both days and to drive students back to school after skating to arrive by noon.

Skates

Students are encouraged to bring their own skates however if skate rental is required the cost is \$5.00 which covers **both** skating days. Payment for skate rental is to be made online at <https://burnaby.schoolcashionline.com/> and the skate ticket at the bottom of this form **must** be completed. Please note that students will have to exchange their shoes for skates at the time of rental.

Instruction

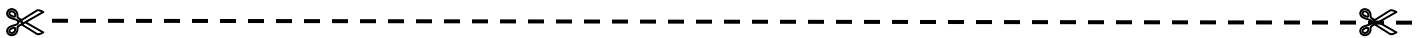
Instructors have not been organized for these skating sessions. If your child is a beginning skater, there are bars and other devices available to support them.

Safety

Children **must** wear a helmet and gloves for safety reasons. Helmets are **mandatory** when on the ice. Students may bring their own helmet or obtain one free of charge at the arena.

Please complete the permission form and return to your child's teacher no later than Friday, November 18th.

Please note that vending machines at the arena are out of bounds, so students should not bring money for snacks or drinks during skating times.
